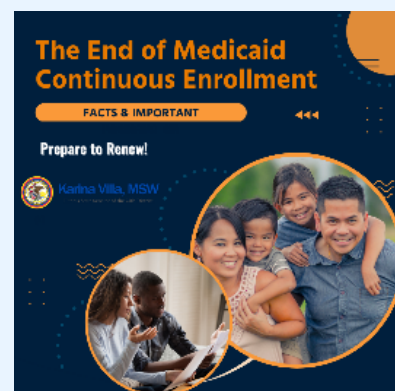

Medicaid Continuous Coverage Ending



The federal government has moved to end continuous coverage for those on Medicaid, which was inserted during the pandemic to ensure individuals and families were not losing coverage even if they were no longer eligible. Everyone on Medicaid will be getting notices that they need to renew their Medicaid insurance within the mail, and can also check online to see when they will need to resubmit their eligibility to the program by logging into their abe.illinois.gov account and going to “Manage My Case” to see when renewal is required. Renewals can be submitted online through this account, by mail or over the phone at 1-800-843-6154. Renewal notices will be mailed to your address the month before they are due to ensure continuous coverage. It is also suggested to make sure your address is current on your Medicaid account to ensure you will receive the letter and other updates regarding your status. DCFS Scholarship

The [DCFS Scholarship Application](#) is now available, youth currently in DCFS care or that have aged out are eligible and have until March 31st, 2023 to apply. Applications can be submitted to DCFS.Scholarship@illinois.gov for consideration. The scholarship covers the full tuition at any community or state college in an effort to assist those that have been involved in the foster care system in obtaining a post-secondary degree. 211 Cook County Launch!



Cook County has officially launched 211, which residents can call to be connected with community-based services. These services range from mental health resources, rental assistance, utility assistance, and more. Residents both within the city and suburban Cook County can both call in to be connected with resources local to them to benefit their current situation. All areas of our district including Cook, Kane, and DuPage can now call 211 for guidance in receiving and being connected to services.

Illinois Housing Development Authority: Opening Doors Program

The Illinois Housing Development Authority has opened its Opening Doors Program which provides \$6,000 in down payment or closing cost assistance to those that apply. As long as the applicant remains in their home for 5 years as their primary residence the money does not have to be repaid and will subtract automatically through their years in the home. First-time home-buyers and minority populations who have had barriers in accessing housing will be prioritized but others can apply as well.
