
#### Legislative Updates

### Welcoming New Staff Members




Please join me in welcoming a new staff member and congratulating a longtime member of my team on her new position!

## Infrastructure Grant Funding for Small Businesses

Small, locally owned businesses in historically underrepresented areas and businesses with fewer than 10 employees should apply by April 7 for up to \$245,000 in grant funding from the Office of Economic Equity and
